Relaxation on Visa & Travel restrictions for Foreign Tourists

- Foreign nationals intending to visit India for tourism purpose will be allowed to enter into India on e-Tourist Visa / Tourist Visa through charted flight (for group tourism only) from 15 October 2021.
- All individual foreign nationals intending to travel to India for tourism purpose through \
 Vande Bharat Mission, Air Bubble Scheme or by any scheduled/non-scheduled
 commercial flights as allowed by the Ministry of Civil Aviation would be permitted to
 enter India from 15 November 2021.
- The above mentioned foreign nationals would be required to obtain a <u>fresh e Tourist / Regular Tourist Visa</u> from BOI or Mission abroad. <u>Existing Valid</u> e-Tourist Visa/Regular Tourist Visa continue to remain suspended.
- Such Foreign nationals will be granted fresh single entry e-Tourist/Regular Tourist for 30 days by BOI/Mission/Post abroad.
- Such Foreign nationals will be permitted to enter India by sea routes or by flights. However, such foreign nationals will not be permitted to enter through land ICPs.
- First 5 lakh tourist visa issued all over the world would be free of charge.
